City of Prescott Elections are underway, with ballots mailed the week of August 3-7. In addition to the Mayoral and Council races, there are a number of ballot initiatives that will help shape the Prescott of the future. Key ballot questions include voter approval for the 2015 General Plan (Question #1) and maintaining funding for open space, and natural places, in our community (Question #4).
