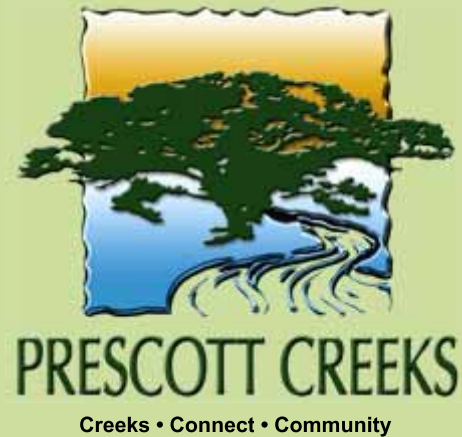

Prescott Creeks partnered with Prescott Audubon in a kestrel nest box program last fall and winter, with three boxes occupied and showing nesting activity this summer. In June, under the careful supervision of AZ Game and Fish Department wildlife experts, staff and volunteers assisted in banding kestrel nestlings.
