Dear Volunteers & Sponsors,

584 people worked together today at the [Granite Creek Cleanup!](#) That's a **21% increase** in the group from last year. Nice! *You made a difference!* It is always a such a pleasure to work with **community volunteers** doing their part to achieve a common goal – make Prescott and its waterways better by being cleaned up.

Now that you've collected the trash and taken to one of the ~20 drop-off locations, the City of Prescott will pick it up and transport it to the Waste Transfer Station on Sundog Ranch Road early Monday morning. We'll have a small crew there to meet the trash and debris as it comes in and they'll conduct a first-ever audit of the Cleanup trash you collected so we can have a better idea of what's being collected out there on the creeks. This may lead to a greater understanding of where the trash is originating and may also lead to campaigns to head it off before it reaches the creek. As we've said before, "We'd love to work ourselves out of a job!"

Once we have a final weight in tons from the City, we'll report back to you in an email and on social media to let you know how big of an impact you've made by participating in the Cleanup.
