

Hi Friend,

Monday we received the tonnage for the trash that almost 500 people collected at the <u>Granite</u> <u>Creek Cleanup</u> on Saturday. The City of Prescott Solid Waste Division reported **1.05 Tons** of trash and debris was collected! That's a decrease of nearly 43% from last year's collection.

This is no surprise for the Cleanup as the 16-year trend is a decrease in trash collected - regardless of participation which is trending upward (see the chart below).




While the total trash collected does vary from year to year depending on a variety of factors, we believe that your participation is making a difference! Also, our lowest collection year was in 2016 where 0.77 Tons of trash was collected. That year, like this year, the Cleanup was preceded by winter storms, so maybe a significant amount of trash was washed downstream into the lakes and/or was inaccessible to Cleanup volunteers in debris piled up by large creek flows.

Good Job!! You helped remove 2,100 pounds of trash from the community!
