Administrative Assistant

Data entry, attend meetings, record, and transcribe minutes, Answer telephones, Filing, Organization of Materials (physical & digital), Prepare event materials, Assist with management and updates to the website, 'Staff' organizational table/booth at events, Light cleaning, And more as need arises.

PR & Social Media Assistant

Help plan and manage content creation and design; review and post as part of Prescott Creeks' overall messaging plan; As needed, attend tours, events, or other locations in the field to capture images/videos; Foster positive and collaborative relationships with the community on Prescott Creeks social media channels (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube); Other duties as assigned.

Website/Database Technician

Update content and system connections; HTML; CSS; JavaScript; Additional needs include SEO and analytics assistance; Prepare monthly analytics reports; Other tasks as needed.

Tour Guide

Conduct periodic tours of Watson Woods Riparian Preserve and Granite Creek Downtown. Participate in training; become confident with presentation material; meet groups at tour start location; deliver 1.5-2 hour tour, respond to follow up questions; coordinate with Prescott Creeks staff regarding record-keeping and performance.

Phenology Trail Monitoring

Monitoring the seasonal changes in plants on one or both Phenology Trails within Watson Woods Riparian Preserve. Coordinate with Prescott Creeks; walk trail(s) weekly, record data in Nature's Notebook App.

Bird Monitoring

IBA Monitoring: Annual Important Bird Area Monitoring 4x/ year/spring and late summer

NestWatch: Observe target nest sites; record data; submit to Prescott Creeks

Photography: Visit riparian area

Field C.R.E.W. (Conservation, Restoration, Education in the Watershed)

CREW is open to anyone wanting to participate in field activities. CREW meets weekly for two hours on Thursday mornings to conduct conservation activities in Watson Woods Riparian Preserve. Recent work has included: non-native vegetation management, data collection and mapping, tree planting, project performance monitoring.
