GUIDELINES for 20 April 2024 Thank you for helping keep Prescott beautiful!

Granite Creek Cleanup:

Welcome! Over 400 people are coming together this year to make a difference in the Prescott community! That's impressive. Things to know: 1) Pre-Registration was required – additional t-shirts are not available. 2) The Drive-Up Sign-In has worked so well, we're sticking with it! 3) Dispersed Outdoor Cleanup Locations – People are assigned to almost 50 locations around the watershed!

Have a fun Granite Creek Cleanup experience and stay safe!

General Recommendations and Guidelines

- 1. <u>APPAREL</u>: We recommend water-resistant, hard-soled shoes or boots, long pants, long sleeved shirts, and work gloves. Don't forget your sunscreen along with a big, shady hat, and water bottle.
- 2. **LEAVE:** Car batteries, barbed wire, hazardous waste, or large items (over 5 ft.) should be left in place. Notify Prescott Creeks personnel of the location. Use the <u>REPORT LARGE DEBRIS APP</u> (See the QR Code on the back of this page), or if possible, return to Granite Creek Park and show us on the map where you found these sorts of items. To get them collected, we will let the proper authorities know.
- 3. <u>DROP-OFF LOCATIONS</u>: Drop-off locations are marked with orange traffic cones and small signs. Please place full trash bags in groups behind the cones. *Do not put bags in dumpsters or on streets, sidewalks, or in driveways.* All <u>bags and collected debris must be visible to collection-truck drivers</u>. Trash removal by the City of Prescott Solid Waste Department will occur after the event. Collected refuse will be weighed and recorded. We'll email you with the results of your work.
- 4. <u>TIRES</u>: If you find tires, please remove as much dirt and debris from the inside the tire as possible. Place tires at drop-off locations in a separate pile so City of Prescott Solid Waste Department can direct them to the appropriate recycle location. Do *NOT* mix tires in with bags!
- 5. <u>CAMPS</u>: If you encounter a suspected homeless camp, evaluate if it appears inhabited (tent sites, medicines, food, etc.). If inhabited, please avoid the camp. If it appears abandoned, <u>carefully</u> proceed with the cleanup. Please also let us know where you found the camp when you return to the park.
- 6. <u>EVENT END TIME</u>: All good things must come to an end... City of Prescott Solid Waste crews will make all the rounds and get us a total collection weight early Monday morning. Please <u>have all collected trash & debris to DROP-OFF</u> locations by 5 PM on Sunday 4/21/2024. We will email you with the results of your work.
- 7. <u>PHOTOS</u>: Please share any pictures, video, or stories you capture of people having a blast while improving their community. Email pictures and video <u>Cleanup@PrescottCreeks.org</u>. ACKER PARK DRAINAGES:

South Virginia St. parking area (by kiosk trash can)

ASPEN CREEK:

Park Ave. and Copper Basin Rd. (NW corner)

BUTTE CREEK:

Lincoln Ave. & Grove Ave. (N end of footbridge)

MILLER CREEK:

<u>Fair St. (NE corner of County building parking lot by dumpster)</u>

<u>Lincoln Ave. & Grove Ave. (N end of footbridge)</u> Madison Ave. (East end on pavement by park)

Miller Creek (North Fork)

Peace Ln. (N end of loop in Iron Springs Manor)

NORTH FORK of GRANITE CREEK:

W. Merritt St. & 1st St. (at low water crossing) 6th St. (both sides – on curb – do not place on roadway)

GRANITE CREEK:

89-South Pull-off (between Haisley Rd. & Peterson Ln.)
Forest Hylands Rd. (at low water crossing)

Leroux St. (at bridge)

N Granite St. (north of railroad trestle at Park entrance)
Granite Creek Park (Dumpster by restrooms)

6th St. (both sides – on curb – do not place on roadway)

Industrial Way & Highway 89 N (NE Corner)
Rosser St. & Highway 89 N (by red gate – do not block)
Peavine Trail/Watson Woods Riparian Preserve Trailhead

(Southwest corner of parking lot)

Willow Creek/Willow Lake:

Willow Lake Rd. (East end of parking adjacent to Britni Dr.)

Report Large Debris




Sometimes certain items are just too hard to collect during the Cleanup Event. We've got an App for that thanks to our partners at the Yavapai County GIS Department.

Use your phone and the QR CODE to the left to quickly access the **Report Large Debris** page on the Prescott Creeks website, navigate maps, and forms to easily report items that you cannot collect during the Cleanup. The information you report is reviewed and forwarded to the appropriate authorities for further action.


